Published bimonthly and distributed to 20,000 readers across the nation, CRO covers corporate responsibility topics and trends.

Eaton is No. 1 among corporate peers

Broad-based data determines rankings

To determine [CRO's 10 Best Corporate Citizens By Industry](#), the magazine used a broad base of data. Fifty-four corporations in the automotive and vehicles industry were evaluated in eight categories: environment, climate change, human rights, employee relations, corporate governance, lobbying, and philanthropy and financial. The final ranking and determination regarding which companies made it on the 10 Best list was made by averaging the ranks within the categories.
